All three photos were taken on April 27th in Kashiwa. The first one (#218) was taken on my way to work, the second one (#235) was taken at work, and the third one (#239) was taken in front of Kashiwa Station just before I got on the Joban Line to go back to central Tokyo.

1) The plaza on the second floor level beside Kashiwa Station. The department store straight ahead is Sogo Department Store... a store that has lost so much money, that the man at the top recently committed suicide. Almost all of the department stores are not doing well, but overall it's probably a good thing for society in general, as people are able to buy things for much more reasonable prices at discount stores now.

2) This was taken in the office at the school I work at in Kashiwa. It's a small office, but this desk arrangement is quite common in Japan... with people all facing each other and working in one big open space. I don't usually go into the office at all, but there was a call from the head office for me... asking me if I could fill in for another teacher that evening (I couldn't).
