


## MP-25 "The Building"



The atrium - looking straight up. The part at the bottom of the photo that breaks the rectangle is the emergency stairwell/default chimney. On the other side of the wall on the right is an elevator-style parking garage. The window side is where the offices are... except the top (twelfth) floor office, which is directly over the doomed ceiling (the black-looking lines are actually stained glass).




